Erwin Chemerinsky, Dean of the new school of law at UCI, is a brilliant scholar and outstanding advocate for many liberal causes. He was inspired to go to law school after witnessing the impact the civil rights lawyers of the 1950's and 1960's had on our society. Even after 28 years he still enjoys teaching law students how to develop a case and think through its difficulties.



As a leading constitutional and civil rights scholar, he has argued high profile cases in these areas before the appellate courts and both the State and Federal Supreme Courts. He regularly contributes articles on the Supreme Court to several legal journals, has written six books and more than 100 Law Review articles. For two years he also chaired the elected Los Angeles Charter Reform Commission, whose recommendations were adopted by the voters in 1999.

As an expert in First Amendment rights, Chemerinsky is eminently qualified to enlighten us on the future of the Supreme Court, its influence on religion in America, and what it will mean for Americans.
