Nonie Darwish

An Infidel for Israel

Nonie Darwish was raised Muslim in Cairo, Egypt and Gaza. Her father was the head of the Egyptian military intelligence in Gaza and the Sinai and oversaw Fedayeen operations against Israel when Gaza was under Egyptian control. When Nonie was just 8 years old in 1956, her father was the victim of the IDF's first targeted assassination.



Ms. Darwish will recount her extraordinary story from being taught to hate Jews in elementary school, to her conversion to Christianity and her transformation to an ardent supporter of Israel.

Nonie Darwish founded www.ArabsForIsrael.com in 2004 and has been speaking extensively on college campuses across the U.S. and Canada. She has appeared on CNN, Fox, MSNBC, Al Arabiya TV and other media outlets as a spokesperson for progress, minority rights, human and women's rights in the Middle East. In her biography, *Now They Call Me Infidel*, she describes the culture behind jihad and martyrdom.
