Victor Raphael

Art at the Intersection of Science and Spirituality

Celebrated artist, Victor Raphael, creates complex and beautiful images that expand conventional views of time and space. Using very sophisticated technology to generate photo-based imagery, the artist elaborates images of stars, novas, and galaxies to produce work that connects the outer-most to the inner-most. The viewer is pulled into deep space and at the same time is invited to contemplate spirituality based on aspects of the infinite. Influenced by his Sephardic roots and teachings of Jewish mysticism, his art invites us to glimpse eternity.



In 2005, Raphael collaborated with Midrash students at Hebrew Union College to produce a permanent installation incorporating Jewish text and ideas emanating from the course's content. For many years, he was the curator of the Platt Gallery of the University of Judaism where he produced over 50 exhibitions. Currently, he is the curator of a 2009 Show & Tell exhibition at the Zimmer Children's Museum.

Raphael also is a founding member of the Jewish Artists Initiative, an advocacy group for Jewish Artists in Southern California.
