Rabbi David Teutsch is the Louis and Myra Wiener Professor of Contemporary Jewish Civilization at Reconstructionist Rabbinical College. After graduating from Harvard, Rabbi Teutsch received his MA in Hebrew letters and rabbinic ordination, and earned his doctorate at the Wharton School of Business at the University of Pennsylvania, where his work focused on organizational ethics. He served as President of RRC from 1993-2002. Rabbi Teutsch is the editor in chief of the groundbreaking seven-volume *Kol Haneshamah* prayer book as well as the author of many other books and articles.
