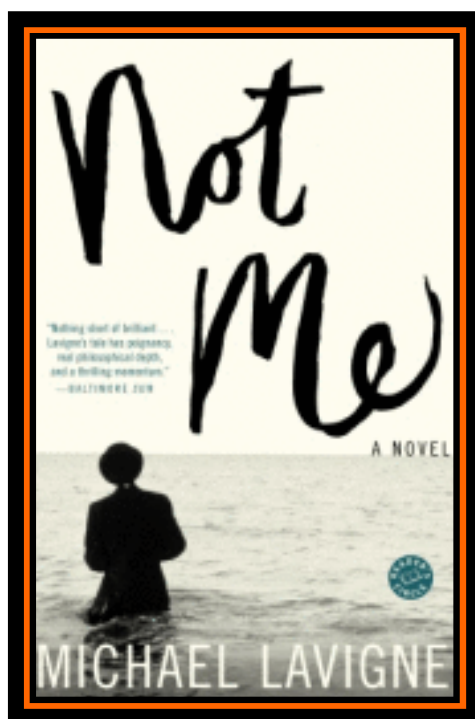


COMING THIS FALL ...
